### Grading MSc (Pharmacy) Kari Jalkanen's doctoral dissertation

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland (1 August 2018), the Faculty Council grades doctoral dissertations. According to Section 13.4 of the standing rules of the Faculty of Health Sciences on degrees and studies, doctoral dissertations are graded on the scale fail – pass – pass with distinction. Passing with distinction requires that two of the three examiners (preliminary examiners and opponent) propose this grade.

MSc (Pharmacy) Kari Jalkanen's doctoral dissertation and study "Modeling the potential economic and quality of life effects of a type 2 diabetes prevention program using Finnish community pharmacies as a recruitment channel" was examined publicly on 5 May 2023. § 4

The Dean's proposal to the Rector of the University of Eastern Finland on the appointment of MD Sanna Toppila-Salmi to the post of Professor, Otorhinolaryngology, until further notice: Hearing of the Faculty Council

By a decision made on 26 September 2022, the Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences approved the description of the post of Professor/Associate Professor (tenure track).

Two applicants submitted their applications to the post by the deadline: MD Sanna Toppila-Salmi and Dr. Med. Aarno Dietz. A summary of the applicants is enclosed with this agenda item as an appendix.

In accordance with the Universities Act, statements must be requested before the appointment on the qualification and merits of the applicants or the person to be invited to the post from a minimum of two experts when a person is being recruited for an employment relationship that will be effective until further notice or for a fixed period of at least two years. Sections 27–29 of the Administrative Procedure Act (434/2003) on disqualification shall be applied to the experts.

According to the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, a person to be appointed as Professor shall be scientifically or

artistically qualified, have good teaching skills and, if important for attending to the duties, have practical familiarity with the field of the post. The Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences has decided on 13 September 2022 that the person to be appointed to the post of Professor, Otorhinolaryngology, is required to have practical familiarity with the field of the post. Practical familiarity is considered to mean that the person has a specialist degree / is a qualified specialist in Otorhinolaryngology and extensive clinical experience in the said specialist field.

Expert statements on the qualification and merits of those applying for the post have been requested from the following persons, in accordance with the Dean's decision of 16 September 2022: Professor Olli-Pekka Alho (University of Oulu) and Professor Danielle Friberg (Uppsala universitet). The statements of the experts are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

Based on the application documents and the expert statements, the Appointments Committee proposes that the vacancy be filled as a post of Professor of Otorhinolaryngology and that MD Sanna Toppila-Salmi be appointed to it from 1 August 2023 onwards until further notice. The proposal of the Appointments Committee and the application documents of Sanna Toppila-Salmi are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

According to section 10(9) of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Dean shall make a proposal to the Rector on the person to be appointed to the post after hearing the Faculty Council.

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will make decisions concerning student admission criteria.

On 31 May 2017, the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Health Sciences decided that the application period for a postgraduate study right ends four times a year: 31 August, 30 November, 28 February and 30 April.
