§ 3

Description of the post of Professor, Neuroepidemiology, in order to invite Associate Professor Alina Solomon to the post: Hearing of the Faculty Council

In its strategic human resources plan, the School of Medicine of the University of Eastern Finland proposes that, if the requirements of the tenure track are met, Alina Solomon may be invited to the post of Professor, Neuroepidemiology, until further notice.

The Tenure Track Committee of the Faculty of Health Sciences has assessed the fulfilment of the specifying criteria and has stated that the invitation procedure and expert evaluation can be started to appoint Associate Professor (Tenure Track) Alina Solomon to the post of Professor.

The post will be hosted by the Faculty of Health Sciences, the School of Medicine, the Institute of Clinical Medicine.

The proposed grounds for the invitation procedure are:

Alina Solomon received a doctoral degree in 2011 from the University of Eastern Finland. She was awarded the title of docent in Neurology in 2014 by the University of Eastern Finland.

Alina Solomon currently works at the School of Medicine of the University of Eastern Finland as an Associate Professor (Tenure Track). She has also



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served as a visiting professor at the School of Public Health, Imperial College London since 2019 and as a senior researcher at the Karolinska Institutet since 2014 and Karolinska Hospital since 2012. Previously, Solomon has also worked, e.g., as an academic researcher and postdoctoral researcher at the University of Eastern Finland.

Alina Solomon's list of publications contains 94 peer-reviewed scientific publications. She has supervised seven and is currently supervising nine doctoral dissertations. She has been the preliminary examiner of a doctoral dissertation two times and an opponent three times. During her tenure track period, Alina Solomon has acquired a total of EUR 1.5 million euros of research funding (UEF's share) from various sources as the main applicant.

Alina Solomon's CV and list of publications are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

On the basis of the above, Associate Professor Alina Solomon fulfils the requirements of the invitation procedure to the post of Professor, Neuroepidemiology.

According to section 33(2) of the Universities Act (558/2009), the professorship may be filled by invitation without a public notice of vacancy when an academically distinguished person is being invited to take the position or a candidate is appointed to the position for a fixed period. Only a person who indisputably fulfils the qualification requirements may be appointed to the post by invitation.





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According to section 31 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, a person to be appointed as Professor shall be scientifically or artistically qualified, have good teaching skills and, if important for attending to the duties, have practical familiarity with the field of the post.

According to the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will discuss proposals on the scope and specifications of the post of a professor and, according to the same, the Dean will decide on the scope and specifications of the post of a professor after hearing the Faculty Council. According to the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Dean will also appoint the experts to provide statements on those who have applied for or have been invited to the post of a professor.

The description of the post of Professor, Neuroepidemiology, is enclosed with this agenda item as an appendix. The description of the post includes the scope and specifications of the post required by the UEF University Regulations. The description of the post does not require that the person invited to the post of Professor of Neuroepidemiology has practical familiarity with the field.

The description of the post also includes a proposal that the invitation procedure is used to invite Associate Professor Alina Solomon to it. Alina Solomon's consent is enclosed with this agenda item as an appendix.

§ 4

The Dean's proposal to the Academic Rector on the person to be appointed as University Lecturer, Health-enhancing physical activity: Hearing of the Faculty Council

According to the UEF University Regulations, the Dean shall make proposals to the Rector on the persons to be appointed to professorships with a term of two years or over, to permanent teaching and research positions compliant with the four-stage research career model and to Tenure Track positions after hearing the Faculty Council.

In accordance with the regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Dean will make a proposal to the Academic Rector on the fulfilment of posts, excluding professors, that comply with the four-stage career model.

A call for applications was organised for the post of University Lecturer (Health-enhancing physical activity) that will be effective until further notice by the Institute of Biomedicine of the University of Eastern Finland's School of Medicine.

Three applicants applied for the post by the deadline: PhD Niina Lintu, DSc (Sport and Health Sciences) Minna Tervo and DSc (Sport and Health Sciences) Marko Korhonen.

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Persons to be appointed as University Lecturers must hold a suitable doctoral degree and have good teaching skills (University Regulations).

Members of the university's teaching and research staff are required to have command of the language they give teaching in (Finnish or Swedish) (Government Decree on Universities 770/2009). The Dean of the faculty can grant an exemption from the language proficiency requirements laid down in the Government Decree on Universities (UEF University Regulations).

All applicants have the required doctoral degree that is suited to the post, as well as merits and achievements related to teaching and research. The appointments Committee noted (Appendix) that of the applicants, PhD Niina Lintu has the strongest merits in teaching and research.

The appointments committee proposes that PhD Niina Lintu be appointed to the post of University Lecturer (Health-enhancing physical activity) from 1 October 2023 onwards.

Niina Lintu received a Master's degree in Health Sciences (Sports Medicine) from the University of Kuopio in 2003 and a doctoral degree in philosophy from the University of Eastern Finland in 2017.

PhD Niina Lintu's CV and list of publications are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

Grading Lic.Med. Jarmo Kuronen's doctoral dissertation

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland (1 August 2022), the Faculty Council grades doctoral dissertations. According to Section 14 of the standing rules of the Faculty of Health Sciences on degrees and studies, doctoral dissertations are graded on the scale fail – pass – pass with distinction. Passing with distinction requires that two of the three examiners (preliminary examiners and opponent) propose this grade.

Lic.Med. Jarmo Kuronen's dissertation and study "Possibilities to prevent permanent work disability retirement in collaboration through disability management and quality networking in occupational healthcare" was examined publicly on 11 August 2023. The opponent, Professor Riitta Sauni (University of Tampere) is in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Medicine and proposes the grade Pass. Both preliminary examiners, Emeritus Professor Eero Lahelma (University of Helsinki) and Emeritus Professor Jukka Uitti (University of Tampere) are in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Medicine and propose the grade Pass.

According to section 44 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), before a doctoral dissertation is graded, the author must be given an opportunity to submit his or her response to the preliminary examiner's, the

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examiner's or the opponent's statement. The doctoral candidate has no comments on the statements. The statements of the preliminary examiners and the opponent are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

According to section 29 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), a study attainment may be assessed only by those members or deputy members of a multi-member administrative body who have a degree or completed study attainments of an equivalent level or who have been appointed professors.

Approval of scoring scales for certificate-based admissions starting from student admissions 2026

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council shall make decisions concerning curricula, degree requirements and student admission criteria.

At the beginning of 2022, the universities launched a project to develop student admissions at the initiative of Unifi's Vice-Rectors in charge of education. The scoring scales for certificate-based admissions have been prepared in the development project for the use of universities in certificate-based admissions.

The draft scoring of certificate-based admissions is based on research and extensive discussions with upper secondary school representatives and students, other stakeholders, and fields of study. Prior to the publication of the draft scoring scales, statements were requested from universities and key stakeholders on the draft. The comments of the faculty's study and degree programmes and any proposed amendments were included in the statement issued by the University of Eastern Finland on the draft scoring scales of certificate-based admissions. Joint admissions have submitted their own comments as part of the statement of the coordinating university.





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The Vice-Rectors in charge of education have submitted the scoring of certificate-based admissions from 2026 onwards to universities for approval in accordance with the appendices. The faculty's study and degree programmes have approved the proposed scoring scales for certificate-based admissions.

Scoring of B languages included in the International Baccalaureate (IB) degree and the ONL included in the European Baccalaureate (EB) degree starting from student admissions 2024

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council shall make decisions concerning curricula, degree requirements and student admission criteria.

The change in the scoring of certificate-based admissions was approved at the meeting of Unifi's Vice-Rectors in charge of education on 16 May 2023. As regards the scoring of certificate-based admissions starting from student admissions 2026, it has been stated that B languages included in the IB degree and the Other National Language (ONL) included in the EB degree must be scored as advanced level languages.

In the current scoring of certificate-based admissions, English is scored as an advanced level language, whilst other B languages included in the International Baccalaureate (IB) degree are scored as intermediate level languages. However, already when the scoring method adopted in 2020 was being prepared, it was stated that comparing the B languages included in the International Baccalaureate (IB) degree with the language studies included in the Finnish matriculation examination is not straightforward. All B languages included in the International Baccalaureate (IB) degree comply with the same curriculum and skill level



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objective, which can be considered to be equivalent to the advanced level of the Finnish matriculation examination. It is, therefore, justified to compare all B languages with the advanced level languages included in the Finnish matriculation examination.

Similarly, the target level of ONL included in the EB degree at the end of the studies is equivalent to the advanced level included in the Finnish matriculation examination, and the scope of the ONL studies is at least the same as that of the advanced level language in the Finnish education system. It is, therefore, justified to compare ONL with the advanced level language included in the Finnish matriculation examination.

Unifi's Vice-Rectors in charge of education propose that all B languages included in the IB degree and the ONL included in the EB degree be scored as advanced level languages. The change will enter into force starting from the student admissions 2024. The change applies to all certificate-based admissions.

The faculty council approves the scoring of B languages included in the International Baccalaureate (IB) degree and the ONL included in the European Baccalaureate (EB) degree starting from student admissions 2024.
