The following post is about to be opened for application:

The School of Medicine, Institute of Clinical Medicine:
Clinical Teacher, Otorhinolaryngology, as from 1 August 2024 until further notice.

The Clinical Lecturer in Otorhinolaryngology is responsible for giving basic and advanced teaching in the field of Otorhinolaryngology, conducting research in the field and for participating in the planning and development of education in the academic subject, in administrative tasks related to teaching and in the supervision of specialising doctors and advanced studies. Grading MSc Eveliina Korhonen's doctoral dissertation

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland (1 August 2022), the Faculty Council grades doctoral dissertations. According to Section 14 of the standing rules of the Faculty of Health Sciences on degrees and studies, doctoral dissertations are graded on the scale fail – pass – pass with distinction. Passing with distinction requires that two of the three examiners (preliminary examiners and opponent) propose this grade.

MSc Eveliina Korhonen's doctoral dissertation and study "Inflammasome activation in response to aberrations of cellular homeostasis in epithelial cells from human cornea and retina" was examined publicly on 15

December 2023. The opponent, Professor Kari Eklund (Helsinki University Hospital) is in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Philosophy and proposes the grade Pass. Both preliminary examiners, Professor Pablo Pelegrín (University of Murcia) and Professor Patricia A. D'Amore (Harvard Medical School) are in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Philosophy and propose the grade Pass with distinction.

According to section 44 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), before a doctoral dissertation is graded, the author must be given an opportunity to submit his or her response to the preliminary examiner's, the examiner's or the opponent's statement. The doctoral candidate has no comments on the statements. The statements of the preliminary examiners and the opponent are enclosed with this agenda item as appendices.

According to section 29 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), a study attainment may be assessed only by those members or deputy members of a multi-member administrative body who have a degree or completed study attainments of an equivalent level or who have been appointed professors.

Admission criteria, non-degree study right subject to a fee, Pharmacy

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will make decisions concerning student admission criteria.

The Department of Pharmacy of the University of Eastern Finland's Faculty of Health Sciences has prepared admission criteria for non-degree study right that is subject to a fee.

A non-degree study right that is subject to a fee is intended for persons who have completed a Bachelor's or a Master's degree in Pharmacy outside Finland and who have applied for the right to act as a health care professional in Finland issued by Valvira. The purpose of the study right is to supplement the Bachelor's or a Master's degree in Pharmacy completed abroad in order for the person to be granted the right to act as a health care professional in Finland.

A student who has been granted a right to study does not have the right to complete a degree at the University of Eastern Finland and does not have the benefits and rights that university degree students have. The right to

complete studies is limited to the studies for which the right was granted. The right to study will be valid for two years.

The admission criteria for the non-degree study right in Pharmacy that is subject to a fee are enclosed with the agenda item as an appendix.

Faculty budget for 2024

According to section 9(1) of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will discuss and issue a statement on the faculty's strategy and budget.

The UEF Board approved on 14 December 2023 the university's budget for 2024:

The funding of faculties has been allocated in accordance with the principles verified by the Board for the internal allocation of funds. The funding of faculties consists of indicator-based funding, strategic funding based on the development plans of the faculties, and other agreed items allocated based on strategic principles. As regards external funding, minimum targets have been specified for each faculty.

The 2024 budget of the Faculty of Health Sciences is enclosed with this agenda item as an appendix.

The basic funding of the 2024 budget of the Faculty of Health Sciences (subsidies), totalling EUR 37.9 million, consists of:

- funding allocated through the funding model
- funding for additional study places
- programme-based funding of the Ministry of Education and Culture
- strategic funding allocated by the University
- Strategy-based funding of the faculties

The total cost of the basic funding in the 2024 budget of the Faculty is EUR 1.8 million higher than in the 2023 budget.

The target level of external funding of the Faculty of Health Sciences for 2024 is EUR 30.5 million. The schools and departments of the faculty have budgeted the revenue from external funding to be EUR 28 million, in addition to which the Faculty has estimated the amount of investment grants to be EUR 1.6 million. The estimated change in the funds is EUR 1.1 million. The estimated revenue from overheads is EUR 6.6 million in the budget (basic funding: internal revenue, revenue from overheads) is based on the budgeting of external funding of the schools and departments of the faculty in 2024.

The University reserves EUR 3.0 million (0% VAT) for investments that will be fully funded with basic funding, of which EUR 1.2 million (0% VAT) is available to the Faculty of Health Sciences.
