Description of the post of Professor, Neurosurgery, in order to invite MD Timo Koivisto to the post: Hearing of the Faculty Council

The School of Medicine, the Institute of Clinical Medicine, of the University of Eastern Finland has proposed in its strategic human resources plan that MD, docent, medical specialist Timo Koivisto be invited to a part-time (30%) post of Professor, Neurosurgery, for a fixed term of four years. The post is filled for a fixed term due to it being a temporary post.

The proposed grounds for the invitation procedure are:

Timo Koivisto received a doctoral degree in Medicine in 2002 from the University of Eastern Finland. He was awarded the title of docent in Neurosurgery in 2008 by the University of Kuopio. In addition, he completed the UEF EMBA degree at the University of Eastern Finland in 2016.

Timo Koivisto currently works as Chief Physician in the Wellbeing Services County of North Savo. He has also acted as a visiting professor at the Macquarie University in Australia (2006-2007). Timo Koivisto's list of publications includes 112 peer-reviewed international scientific publications. He has supervised 7 doctoral dissertations and is currently

supervising two more. He has also acted several times as a preliminary examiner and opponent of doctoral dissertations. Timo Koivisto has acquired almost EUR 3.0 million of research funding as the leading principal investigator or a member of a research team.

On the basis of the above, Timo Koivisto meets the requirements of the invitation procedure for the part-time (30%) post of Professor, Neurosurgery.

According to section 33 of the Universities Act (558/2009), the professorship may be filled by invitation without a public notice of vacancy when an academically distinguished person is being invited to take the position or a candidate is appointed to the position for a fixed period. Only a person who indisputably fulfils the qualification requirements may be appointed to the post by invitation.

According to section 31 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, a person to be appointed to a permanent professorship or to a professorship that lasts for over two years shall be scientifically or artistically qualified, have good teaching skills and, if important for the successful performance of their duties, practical knowledge of the scope of the post.

According to section 10 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Dean will decide on the scope and specifications of the professor's position after consulting the Faculty Council. The Dean will decide whether the professor is required to have practical knowledge of

the scope of the post. The Dean will make a proposal to the Rector on a person to be appointed as a professor for two years or more after consulting the Faculty Council.

The description of the post of Professor, Neurosurgery, is enclosed with this agenda item as an annex. The description of the post includes the scope and specifications of the post required by the UEF University Regulations. The description of the post requires that the person to be invited to the said post of Professor has practical familiarity with the field of the post.

# Granting the title of docent in Pharmacoeconomics, to PhD (Pharm.) Timo Purmonen

PhD (Pharmacy) Timo Purmonen has proposed that he be granted the title of Docent in the field of Pharmacoeconomics at the University of Eastern Finland, Faculty of Health Sciences. The applicant's CV and list of publications are attached.

The Faculty of Health Sciences' Docent Committee has noted in its meeting that the docentship is appropriate in terms of teaching and research. The Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences has invited Professor Zanfina Ademi Delaney (Monash University) and Associate Professor Liza Sopina (DaCHE) as experts.

Professor Ademi Delaney submitted her statement on 18 October 2025 and Professor Sopina on 1 October 2025. Both experts consider the applicant scientifically qualified for the docentship applied for and support granting the title of Docent. The experts' statements are attached.

According to Section 89 of the Universities Act (558/2009), the university may, upon application, grant the title of Docent to a person who has profound knowledge of their field, a demonstrated ability for independent research or artistic work through publications or otherwise, and good teaching skills.

Description of the post of Professor, Pathology, especially Neuropathology, in order to invite MD Tuomas Rauramaa to the post: Hearing of the Faculty Council

The School of Medicine, the Institute of Clinical Medicine at the University of Eastern Finland has proposed in its strategic personnel plan that MD, Docent, Specialist Physician Tuomas Rauramaa be invited to the position of Professor of Pathology, especially Neuropathology, on a permanent basis.

The grounds for the invitation procedure are as follows:

Tuomas Rauramaa completed the Doctor of Medicine degree in 2016 at the University of Eastern Finland. He qualified as a Specialist Physician in Pathology in 2012 at the University of Eastern Finland. He was granted the title of Docent in Pathology, especially Neuropathology, in 2020 by the University of Eastern Finland. In addition, Rauramaa was awarded special competence in neuropathology in 2015 and special competence as a medical educator in 2019.

Tuomas Rauramaa currently serves as Professor of Neuropathology at the University of Eastern Finland and as Associate Chief Physician in the North Savo Wellbeing Services County. Rauramaa's publication list includes 86 peer-reviewed international scientific publications. He has supervised two doctoral dissertations and is currently supervising three. He has also frequently served as a pre-examiner of doctoral dissertations. Tuomas Rauramaa has secured approximately EUR 2.2

million in research funding as principal investigator or as a member of a research group.

On the basis of the above, Tuomas Rauramaa meets the requirements for the invitation procedure for the position of Professor of Pathology, especially Neuropathology.

According to Section 33 of the Universities Act (558/2009), a professorship may be filled by invitation without an open call when a distinguished person can be invited to the position or when the position is filled for a fixed term. Only a person who indisputably meets the qualification requirements may be selected by invitation. According to Section 31 of the University of Eastern Finland's Rules of Procedure, a person appointed to a professorship on a permanent basis or for a term of more than two years must be scientifically or artistically competent, possess good teaching skills, and, if it is important for the performance of the duties, have practical familiarity with the field.

According to Section 10 of the University of Eastern Finland's Rules of Procedure, the Dean decides on the scope of duties and the job description of a professorship after consulting the Faculty Council. The Dean decides whether practical familiarity with the field is required of the professor. The Dean makes a proposal to the Rector, for a period of two years or longer, regarding the person to be appointed to the professorship, after consulting the Faculty Council.

The position filling memorandum for the Professor of Pathology, especially Neuropathology, is attached. The memorandum contains the scope of duties and job description as required by the Rules of Procedure. The memorandum requires
