# Supplementing the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Science, Forestry and Technology: Professor quota

Professor Pekka Toivanen, a deputy member of the Professor quota of the Faculty Council, has been appointed as a member of the UEF Board for the remainder of the Board's term of office, so he cannot continue as a deputy member of the Faculty Council (section 9 of the UEF University Regulations). A new deputy member cannot be appointed in his place (as the deputy of Professor Pauli Miettinen) on the basis of the results of the elections, as the number of candidates in the said quota was the same as the number of selected candidates (10).

According to section 13(2) and (4) of the Elections Regulations, (1 July 2021):

If a member of the University Collegiate Body or the Faculty Council loses their eligibility or resigns from the administrative body at their own request, the person's personal deputy member shall take the person's place for the remaining period. If a deputy member loses their eligibility, resigns at their own request, or becomes a member of the administrative body, the University Collegiate Body shall appoint a new deputy member to the University Collegiate Body, and the Faculty Council shall appoint a new deputy member to the Faculty Council for the remaining term on the

basis of the results of the election or, if this is not possible, after having heard the opinion of the group concerned.

When selecting a deputy member to the University Collegiate Body or a member to the Board in the middle of the term, the procedure by which the staff group concerned is heard shall be decided by the chair of the University Collegiate Body; and when selecting a deputy member to the Faculty Council, by the Dean.

The Dean of the Faculty has decided that the Faculty Council's quotas will be supplemented in accordance with the instructions of the Election Commission as follows: The Executive Head of Administration shall convene the relevant staff groups by e-mail. The invitation shall state that the matter concerns supplementing an administrative body and that the person to be proposed will be selected at the event. The proposed persons will be presented at the meeting. If the number of candidates is higher than the number of available places, those who have arrived at the event will vote on the person to be proposed. In this case, the hearing process will be carried out when the candidate is selected. The process is the same for both professors and other staff (Annex to the Dean's decision).

The meeting concerning the professor quota was organised on 26 September 2025, and Professor Jani Virta from the Department of Physics and Mathematics of the Faculty was proposed to be appointed as a personal deputy of Professor Pauli Miettinen, and his appointment to the

Supplementing the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Science, Forestry and Technology: Other teaching and research staff and other staff quota

Senior Laboratory Technician Tarja Virrantalo, member of the Other teaching and research staff and other staff quota of the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Science, Forestry and Technology, is no longer employed by the university and is therefore no longer eligible for election. Her personal deputy, University Lecturer Juho Kopra, will replace her as a member of the Faculty Council. A new deputy member cannot be appointed for Kopra on the basis of the results of the elections, as the number of candidates in the said quota was the same as the number of selected candidates (10).

According to section 13(2) and (4) of the Elections Regulations, (1 July 2021):

If a member of the University Collegiate Body or the Faculty Council loses their eligibility or resigns from the administrative body at their own request, the person's personal deputy member shall take the person's place for the remaining period. If a deputy member loses their eligibility, resigns at their own request, or becomes a member of the administrative body, the University Collegiate Body shall appoint a new deputy member to the University Collegiate Body, and the Faculty Council shall appoint a new deputy member to the Faculty Council for the remaining term on the

The Dean of the Faculty has decided that the Faculty Council's quotas will be supplemented in accordance with the instructions of the Election Commission as follows: The Executive Head of Administration shall convene the relevant staff groups by e-mail. The invitation shall state that the matter concerns supplementing an administrative body and that the person to be proposed will be selected at the event. The scope and specifications of the post of University Lecturer in chemical technology and virtual environments that will become vacant at the Faculty. Hearing of the Faculty Council

In accordance with the human resources planning of the faculty and the Department of Chemistry and Sustainable Technology, the aim is to open a call for the post of University Lecturer, in the field of chemical technology and virtual environments, at the Department of Chemistry and Sustainable Technology on the Joensuu campus. The post will support the department's research in the functional materials sector.

The description of the post is as follows:

The University Lecturer's role is teaching-oriented and the field of teaching is chemical technology and virtual environments. The duties will include teaching and supervision duties included in the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes of the department, including the planning, development and implementation of teaching, in particular in the thematic areas of teaching and laboratory training in chemistry and in cooperation with other actors in the field. The duties also include the development of multidisciplinary learning environments and teaching methods, with a

special focus on digital virtual environments in laboratory teaching of chemistry and technology. The duties include independent research and related acquisition of resources.

The University Lecturer will act as the responsible teacher in the PSP counselling of Bachelor students of chemistry, in the identification of skills (RPL) and in LUMA cooperation. The person to be appointed to the position is expected to have good skills in the Finnish language and be able to teach in English and in also online learning environments.

According to section 11 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will discuss proposals regarding the scope and specifications of posts that comply with the four-stage career model of the faculty's permanent and Tenure Track positions.
