Grading MEd Sanni Kahila's doctoral dissertation in the field of Education, especially Early Childhood Education

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland (1 August 2018), the Faculty Council grades doctoral dissertations. According to the instructions issued separately by the Philosophical Faculty (24 May 2023), doctoral dissertations are graded on the scale fail – pass – pass with distinction.

MEd Sanni Kahila's doctoral dissertation and study "Conforming to practices or developing them? - Students' discourses and practicum experiences on teacher expertise and leadership in multiprofessional early childhood education teams" was examined publicly on 27 February 2025. The opponent Professor (Emerita) Inkeri Ruokonen (University of Turku) is in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Education and proposes the grade Pass with distinction.

According to section 44 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), before a doctoral dissertation is graded, the author must be given an opportunity to submit his or her response to the preliminary examiner's, the examiner's or the opponent's statement. The doctoral candidate has no

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comments on the statement. The statements of the opponent and the custos are enclosed with this agenda item as annexes.

According to section 29 of the Universities Act (24.7.2009/558), a study attainment may be assessed only by those members or deputy members of a multi-member administrative body who have a degree or completed study attainments of an equivalent level or who have been appointed professors.

The Dean's proposal to appoint DEd Soila Lemmetty to the post of Associate Professor (Tenure Track), Adult Education: consultation of the Faculty Council

According to section 10(9) of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Dean shall make proposals to the Rector on the persons to be appointed to professorships with a term of two years or over, and to Tenure Track positions after hearing the Faculty Council.

The post of Associate Professor (Tenure Track), Adult Education, is hosted by the School of Educational Sciences and Psychology. According to the description of the post:

The duties of the Associate Professor include conducting research in the field of adult education, participating in doctoral education, supervising postgraduate students, applying for external funding for research projects, and leading and developing a research group. The Associate Professor develops research in adult education, promotes interdisciplinary collaboration and organises research projects. The duties of the Associate Professor include giving teaching in adult education as part of education offered by the School in different subjects at the basic, intermediate and advanced levels, as well as supervising Master's theses. The Associate Professor will promote the societal impact and interaction in their field.

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The person to be appointed is expected to have:

- *a suitable doctoral degree,*
- *good teaching skills,*
- *demonstrated achievements in independent scientific research (including publications and research funding),*
- *a track record of international scientific activities,*
- *experience of supervision and teaching,*
- *fluency in the Finnish language and the ability to teach and supervise in English.*

The following will be considered an advantage:

- *national and international positions of trust,*
- *societal impact and activities, and*
- *studies in university pedagogy or other pedagogical teaching merits.*

When assessing research achievements, the applicant's scientific publications, national and international research collaboration, experience in leading a research group, and applications for external funding will be taken into consideration. When assessing teaching and supervision achievements, the applicant's teaching portfolio and experience in supervising theses at different levels will be taken into consideration.

The post will be filled for a fixed term of four (4) years starting on 1 February, or as agreed. The post is filled for a fixed term due to it being a Tenure Track position."

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The post of Associate Professor (Tenure Track), adult education, involves the direct recruitment of Soila Lemmetty to the post. The direct recruitment was prepared by the Appointments Committee appointed by the Dean (Dean Ilkka Huhta (Chair), Professor Hille Janhonen-Abuquah, Senior University Lecturer Aino Äikäs, Professor Sonja Kosunen and Professor Heidi Hyytinen).

Expert statements have been requested on the merits of Soila Lemmetty to the post of Associate Professor from Professor Ulpukka Isopahkala-Bouret (University of Turku) and Professor Hanna Toiviainen (University of Tampere). Based on the statements, Soila Lemmetty has the qualifications and merits required by the post of Associate Professor and the prerequisites to meet the qualification requirements of Professor by the end of the tenure track term.

The Appointments Committee of the post proposes unanimously that, based on the expert statements and application documents, Soila Lemmetty be appointed to the post of Associate Professor.

The Chair of the Appointments Committee has decided to exempt Soila Lemmetty from the requirement to give a trial lecture, as her teaching merits can be verified based on the application documents. Soila Lemmetty meets the requirements laid down in the UEF University Regulations for the employment of Associate Professor and the requirements indicated in the description of the post.

The Dean's proposal to the Rector is that DEd Soila Lemmetty is appointed to the post of Associate Professor (Tenure Track),

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Adult Education, for a fixed term of four years as from 1 April 2026 onwards. The post is filled for a fixed term due to it being a Tenure Track position.
