Grading LicSocSc Salme Kallinen's doctoral dissertation in the field of Social Work

LicSocSc Salme Kallinen's doctoral dissertation and study

"Aikuissosiaalityön asiakasdokumentaatio sosiaalityön itseymmärryksen kuvana" was examined publicly on 24 April 2026. The opponent, Docent, DSSc Jari Lindh (University of Lapland) is in favour of the dissertation being approved as a thesis for a doctoral degree in Social Sciences and proposes the grade Pass.

According to section 44 of the Universities Act (558/2009), before a doctoral dissertation is graded, the author must be given an opportunity to submit his or her response to the preliminary examiner's, the examiner's or the opponent's statement. The doctoral candidate has no comments on the statement. The statements of the opponent and the custos are enclosed with this agenda item as annexes.

According to section 9 of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland (12 December 2023), the Faculty Council grades doctoral dissertations. According to Section 32 of the Education Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, dissertations are graded on the scale fail - pass - pass with distinction.

Considering the English-language matriculation examination in certificate-based admissions as from 2029

According to section 9.4(6) of the University Regulations of the University of Eastern Finland, the Faculty Council will make decisions concerning curricula and student admission criteria.

As from autumn 2028, the matriculation examination may be taken in Finnish, Swedish or English (Act on the Matriculation Examination 502/2019). The structure of the examination is the same in all languages. The English-language examination requires that the person has completed the Finnish as a second language (S2) or Swedish as a second language (R2) test. The test is determined by the language of instruction in upper secondary education. The English-language matriculation examinations implemented as translations, i.e., the content is the same in all languages.

Motion

In accordance with the Act on the Organisation of the Matriculation Examination (502/2019), English-language matriculation examinations will, as from 2029, be observed in the certificate-based admissions of universities in the same way as corresponding matriculation examinations completed in Finnish or Swedish.

Granting the title of docent to PhD Ahjond Garmestani

PhD Ahjond Garmestani has applied for the title of docent in Law, especially Environmental Law at the University of Eastern Finland. The application for the title of docent was initiated on 30 September 2024 at the Faculty of Social Sciences and Business Studies of the University of Eastern Finland.

In accordance with section 89 of the Universities Act (558/2009), the university may award the title of docent upon application to a person who has comprehensive knowledge of his or her own field, a capacity for independent research or artistic work demonstrated through publications or some other manner, and good teaching skills.

The Law School has considered the title of docent applied for by PhD Ahjond Garmestani to be purposeful for the teaching and research of the School based on the following grounds: "Ahjond Garmestani is one of the most cited scholars in environmental law globally. He is a close partner of the School and is, for example, a member of the steering group of the ongoing STN/RELIEF project. He has taught the theoretical starting points of environmental law, e.g., at the Utrecht University in the Netherlands, and is interested in teaching at UEF as well."

The Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Business Studies decided to invite (19 December 2024) Professor Maria Pettersson (Luleå University of Technology, Sweden), and Professor Holly Doremus (University of California, Berkeley) as experts to provide statements on the scientific qualifications of PhD Garmestani for the title of docent in Law, especially Environmental Law. Professor Doremus did not submit her opinion despite repeated requests, so on 25 February 2026 the Dean invited a third expert, Professor Josephine van Zeben (European University Institute), to provide a statement. Both experts (Pettersson and van Zeben) are in favour of awarding the title of docent to Garmestani.

A person to be awarded the title of docent is required to have good teaching skills (Universities Act 558/2009). The Dean may exempt the applicant from the requirement to give a trial lecture if the teaching merits can be verified in some other manner in accordance with the faculty's instructions on awarding the title of docent. By a decision of 21 April 2026, the Dean has exempted Garmestani from the requirement to give a trial lecture and has determined his teaching merits based on the application documents.

According to section 9 of the UEF University Regulations, the Faculty Council shall decide on awarding the title of docent.

Granting the title of docent to LLD Juhana Riekkinen

LLD Juhana Riekkinen has applied for the title of docent in Law, especially Procedural Law, at the University of Eastern Finland. The application for the title of docent was initiated on 15 December 2025 at the Faculty of Social Sciences and Business Studies of the University of Eastern Finland.

In accordance with section 89 of the Universities Act (558/2009), the university may award the title of docent upon application to a person who has comprehensive knowledge of his or her own field, a capacity for independent research or artistic work demonstrated through publications or some other manner, and good teaching skills.

The Law School has considered the title of docent applied for by LLD Juhana Riekkinen to be purposeful for the teaching and research of the School based on the following grounds: "Riekkinen is a key specialist in procedural law, and his expertise also extends significantly to legal informatics. His expertise at the interface of procedural law and legal informatics would bring to the School expertise that is not currently available to the same extent, and would therefore strengthen the teaching offered and the research conducted by the School in these fields.

Riekkinen has international networks and international publication activities, and he has the prerequisites to act as an active research partner in the department's projects. The title of docent would create a natural framework for goal-oriented teaching and research cooperation with the School and strengthen the research community, especially in the areas of procedural law and legal informatics."

The Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Business Studies decided to invite (16 March 2026) Professor Laura Ervo (University of Helsinki) and LLD Antti Tapanila (Pirkanmaa District Court) as experts to provide their statements on the scientific qualifications of LLD Juhana Riekkinen for the title of docent in Law, especially Procedural Law. Both experts are in favour of awarding the title of docent to Riekkinen.

A person to be awarded the title of docent is required to have good teaching skills (Universities Act 558/2009). The Dean may exempt the applicant from the requirement to give a trial lecture if the teaching merits can be verified in some other manner in accordance with the faculty's instructions on awarding the title of docent. By a decision of 8 May 2026, the Dean has exempted Riekkinen from the requirement to give a trial lecture and has determined his teaching merits based on the application documents.
